
THE WORD

May the LORD fulfill the words you have prophesied and bring back the vessels of the LORD's house, and may he bring back all the exiles from Babylon to this place. ⁷Nevertheless, listen now to what I have to say in your hearing and in the hearing of all the people. ⁸The prophets from ancient times who came before you and me prophesied war, famine, and plague against many countries and great kingdoms. ⁹As for the prophet who prophesies peace, only when the word of that prophet actually happens will that prophet become known as someone whom the Lord has truly sent."

SECOND LESSON Romans 6:1b-11 (EHV)


¹Shall we keep on sinning so that grace may increase? ²Absolutely not! We died to sin. How can we go on living in it any longer? ³Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴We were therefore buried with him by this baptism into his death, so that just as he was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too would also walk in a new life.

⁵For if we have been united with him in the likeness of his death, we will certainly also be united with him in the likeness of his resurrection.

⁶We know that our old self was crucified with him, to make our sinful body powerless, so that we would not continue to serve sin. ⁷For the person who has died has been declared free from sin. ⁸And since we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹We know that since Christ has been raised from the dead, he will never die again. Death no longer has control over him. ¹⁰For the death he died, he died to sin once and for all, but the life he lives, he lives to God. ¹¹In the same way also consider yourselves dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

³⁴"Do not think that I came to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. ³⁵For I came to turn a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. ³⁶A man's enemies will be the members of his own household.

³⁷"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. ³⁸Whoever does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. ³⁹Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

⁴⁰"Whoever receives me, and whoever receives me receives him who sent me. ⁴¹Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward. Whoever receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward. ⁴²Whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water to drink because he is my disciple—Amen I tell you—he will never lose his reward."


M: Now, eternal God and Father, keep us in the saving faith and so enable us to overcome all things through our Lord Jesus Christ.







QUARTERLY OPEN FORUM AND VOTERS MEETING AFTER WORSHIP TODAY

Today following our worship, we will hold our quarterly Open Forum, followed by our Voters' Meeting. At this meeting we will be considering a proposed change to the church bylaws, recommended by the council, as follows:

- 1. Remove Article II, Section 4 that currently addresses a voting membership requirement of attending at least one voters meeting per year and change it to what already is in place under Article II, Section 1 which reads that voting membership shall be restricted to male communicant members eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- 2. Under Article IV, Section 2 the bylaws state that the term of office for all officer positions shall be two (2) years. A person shall not hold the same office for more than two (2) consecutive terms. The church council is recommending that this section of the bylaws be changed to the following: The term limit requirement for church officer positions may be suspended as needed, and this shall be reviewed on a yearly basis, at the regularly scheduled voters meeting held in January of each year.
